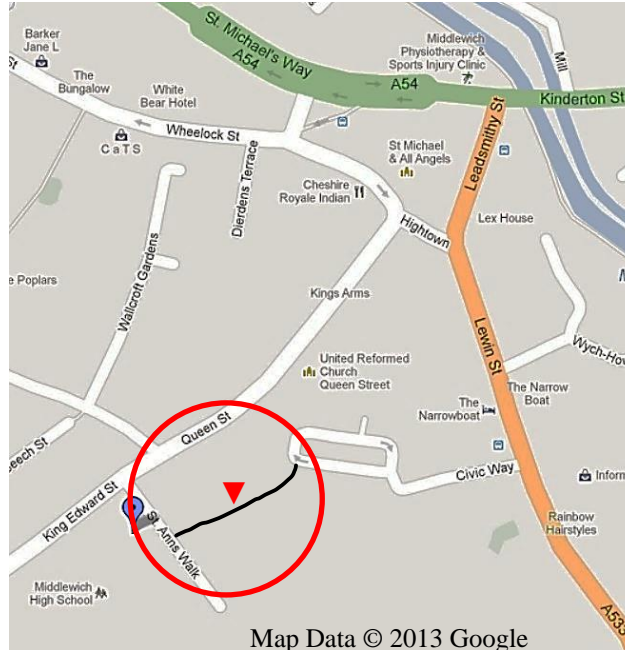

The Community Centre (▼) is on the pedestrian walkway which runs from St Anns Walk (between the Community Centre and Oakland Medical Centre [Sat-Nav: [CW10 9BE](#)]) to the Victoria Hall car park at the top of Civic Way [Sat-Nav: [CW10 9BX](#)].

There are 3 **FREE** car parks. One is by the Victoria Hall (at the end of Civic Way). The other two are at the end of St Anns Walk by the Leisure Centre (go left OR right after passing Rowlands Pharmacy). St Anns Walk is off King Edward Street / Queen Street opposite Home Bargains.
