

Middlewich Community Centre (▼) is on the pedestrian walkway which runs from St Anns Walk (between the Community Centre and Oakland Medical Centre [Sat-Nav: CW10 9BE]) to the Victoria Hall car park at the top of Civic Way [Sat-Nav: CW10 9BX]. St Anns Walk is off King Edward Street / Queen Street opposite the entrance to Home Bargains.
